The code of conduct for students

- Students must be on time and ask for permission before leaving or entering during lecture sessions.
 Ragging is strictly forbidden on and off college property, and anyone found guilty may face severe consequences.
- The use of electronic devices is strictly prohibited in classrooms, examination halls, libraries, and laboratories.
- Students should dress plainly and respectfully.
